Acceptable Use Policy

Students using the school's network are required to abide by the "Acceptable Use Policy". Here we will highlight a few of the more important portions for High School students for use of quick reference. However, all students and parents are still expected to read and abide by the full version of the policy.

- If the administration becomes aware of any inappropriate/illegal actions, at any time, it will take immediate and appropriate action. Suspension of privilege is the likely ramification.
- Representing yourself as another person is prohibited.
- No posting of any offensive, obnoxious, or inappropriate language/material.
- Unless otherwise approved by a teacher/administrator, a student's use of the computers/network is to be for schoolwork and assignments only.
- Student is responsible for any and all downloads they perform along with any resulting damages that it may cause.

Homework Policy

All assignments must be turned in at the beginning of class. Any assignments turned in after this point will be regarded as "late" and will have points removed from the score. 20% of the total assignment points will be removed for each day the assignment is late.
